I. <u>Quorum</u> A quorum of the Board shall consist of four members. No official acti.6(u)- shall be taken when a quorum is absent.

II. <u>Vot6(u</u>)Twe Board shall act by majority vote of all of the membership of the Board, unless a higher level of Board votes is required. A roll call vote sall be taken whe- requested by any Trustee or as otherwise required by law. No action shall be taken by secret ballot.

At times, a super majority or unanimous vote is required by law. These instances include, but are not limited to, a twethirds vote of all members present or unanimous vote if less than two thirds of the Board is present to override the failure to agendize an item when the need to act arose after the agenda was posted, and **the** or unanimous votes required for certain actions concerning District real and personal property.

The Chancellor shall include special voting requirements on agendas.
