The District will ensure that all new, newly-added, or modified online content and functionality will be accessible to people with disabilities as measured by conformance to the World Wide Web Consortium's (W3C's) Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0 Level AA and the Web Accessibility Initiative Accessible Rich Internet Applications Suite (WAI-ARIA) 1.0 techniques for web content, which are incorporated by reference.

The District's adherence to these accessible technology standards will ensure compliance with underlying legal obligations that individuals with disabilities are guaranteed access to educational institutions and systems of communication under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.
