13.G. Assignment of Overload and Overload Compensation In the District's Automotive/Trade-Skills Department

1. Automotive Department full-time faculty members are not entitled to a guaranteedoverload/extra pay assignment.

2. Available overload/extra pay assignments, as determined by management, shall be made on a rotational basis among qualified Automotive faculty members, starting with the most senior qualified faculty member. Consistent with the Faculty Handbook, (1) overload assignments shall
